

Poison Centres – A CHCS Webinar

On 22 March 2017, the Commission adopted a Regulation on poison centres improving the availability of information needed in case of poisoning. COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) 2017/542 amends Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 and applies from 1st January 2020.

The Regulation will apply to mixtures for consumer use as of 2020. It also targets mixtures for professional and industrial use, for which requirements apply as of 2021 and 2024, respectively.

Caroline will give an overview of the new Annex VIII to CLP outlining the new harmonised requirements.

The amending regulation adds the paragraph '*Where under Annex VIII the submitter creates a Unique Formula Identifier, it shall be included on the label in accordance with the provisions of section 5 of Part A of that Annex*' to Article 25 of CLP and states that the remainder of the requirements are set out in Annex VIII of CLP.
